Consequences

What will happen if you make the wrong choices:

Stage 1: Say the school rule and you will make a choice.

Stage 2: You will be told what you're doing wrong and you will have to make a choice.

Stage 3: Time out of class and you will miss some break time.

Stage 4: If you continue to do the wrong thing, you will be sent to Mrs Jamalizadeh or Miss Mc Nicholas and you will miss lunch times.

Stage 5: If you continue to make the wrong thing you've already been sent to Mrs Jamalizadeh or Miss McNicholas, you will lose your lunchtime breaks and your parents/guardians will come to school to find out what has happened.
