Remember you might only read one or two pages or even your own book. It still counts! ☺

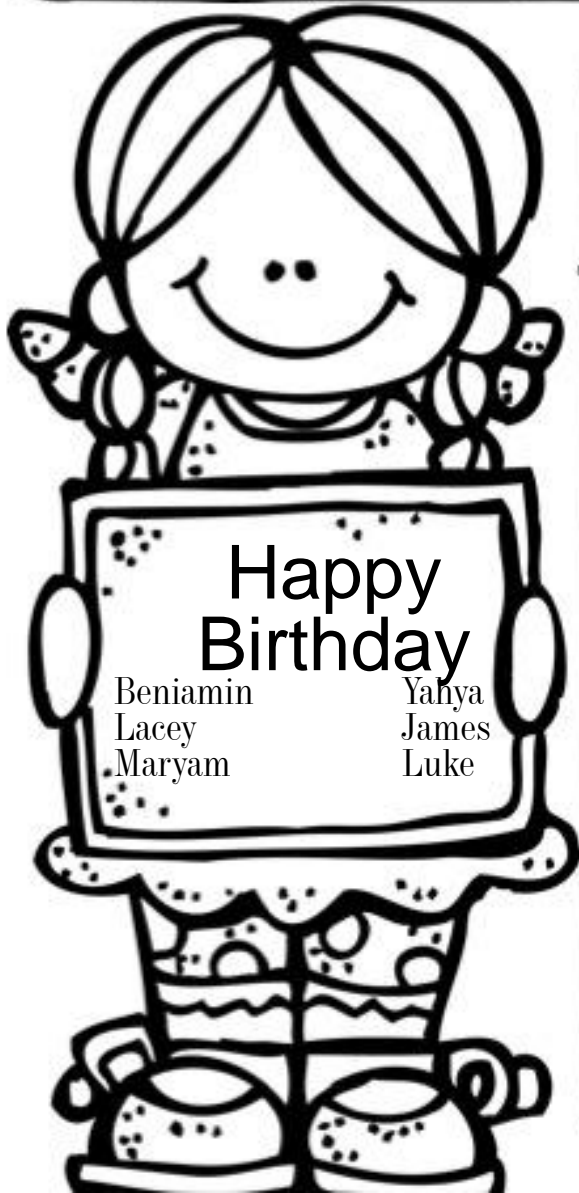
