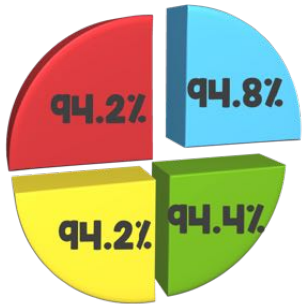

I hope you will be able to join us next Friday. If so, please collect your child from their usual dismissal points at the end of the school day and make your way into school via the main reception entrance.

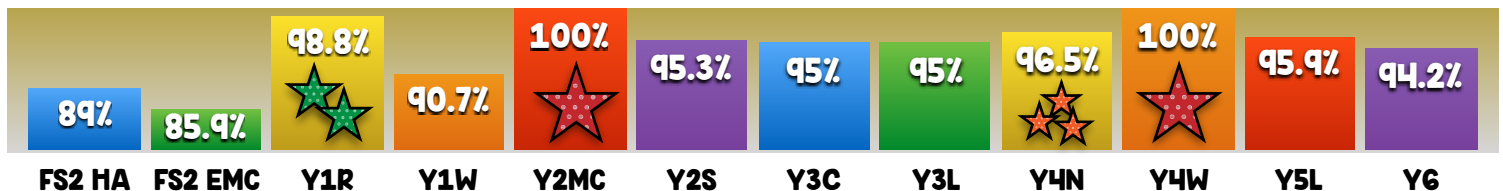
Please remember to return your child's permission slip and donation for them to attend Cineworld on the 19th December 2017.
