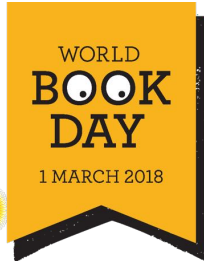

- ❖ Do not drink alcohol when with children

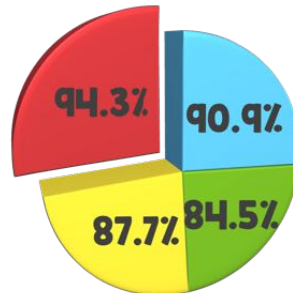

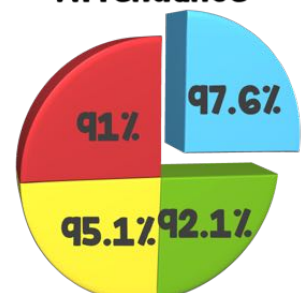
