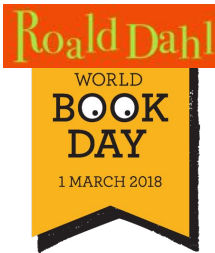

Dear Parents/Guardians,

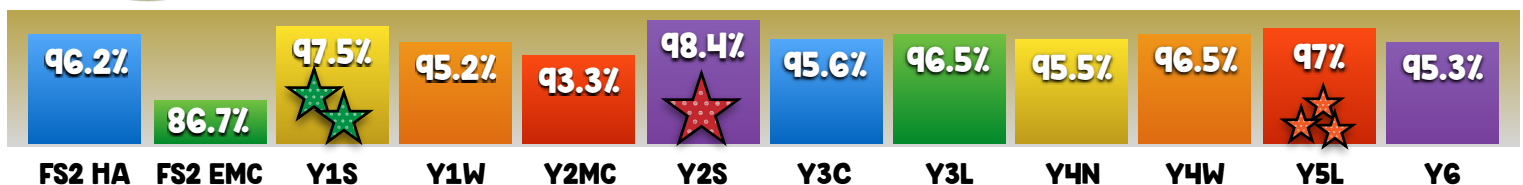
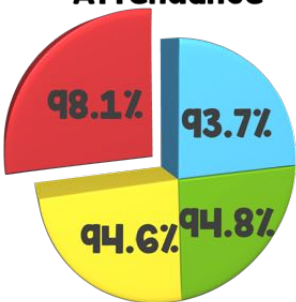

I realise that this is just a minority of parents, but for those of you who continue to disregard the fact that there is parking restrictions on the Grove, I would ask you again to please **NOT park on St Margaret's Grove** and show some respect and kindness to the residents.
