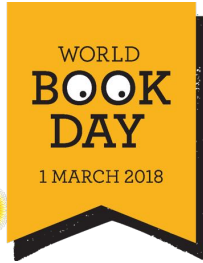

Dear Parents/Guardians,

In our whole school collective worships we have been concentrating on the last two weeks Gospel readings from Sunday Mass. 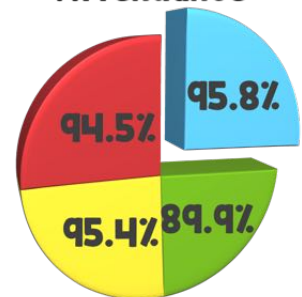
I would be very grateful if you could support your children with their personal relationship with God and when take the opportunity to join them in prayer.

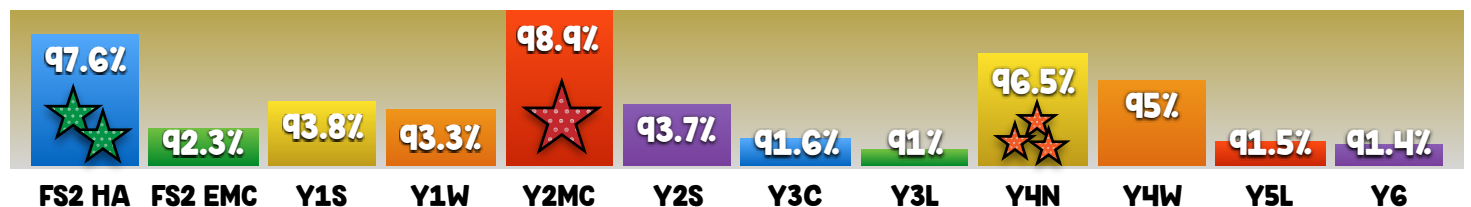
